Consider the following prompts to help you with your brainstorming session:

- Your first date
- Other memorable dates
- Shared interests, hobbies and activities
- Milestone moments such as moving in together, buying your first home, additional family members like kids and pets
- Travel experiences
- Funny memories/stories
- Things you love about each other
- The proposal story
- Plans for the future

When you think about your partner and your relationship so far, what are the moments that you look back on and smile? These memorable moments are usually the best places to start when it comes to writing an authentic and engaging Love Story.

Having a few entertaining short stories I can tell everyone about you two doesn't have to be lengthy but at the same time we don't want to rush through it. I find that a Love Story lasting about 10-12 min is perfect. However, a very engaging and authentically fun story can easily be much longer without even feeling like it! The more you put into your Love Story, the better engaged your guests become and leads to a fun and memorable night for everyone!
